Ham frequencies: Use repeaters like 147.00- 136.5 PL or 147.555 simplex Sacramento side. Use SRH 147.51 simplex East side and Lone Pine. Strong signals block 147.51 on Sacramento side. SSB nets 8 PM 3.9185 MHz - SRH net Mon-Fri - Mt Vaca net Sat,

Directions: From Hwy 395 in Lone Pine, at the only traffic light, drive 3.5 miles west on Whitney Portal Road (Ignore Tuttle Creek Rd at edge of town!), then 1.5 miles south on Horseshoe Meadow Road. Follow signs. Latitude 36.565, Longitude -118.127 There are 83 RV/tent sites at \$5/night, ½ off with a Federal card, tables, campfire rings, water faucets, vault toilets, dump station \$5.

Lone Pine: Three gas stations, well stocked market, drug store, excellent hardware, restaurants, pizza, McDonald's, Carl's Jr., several motels.

An optional Ham Radio activity is the annual Whitney Classic 135 mile charity bike ride from Death Valley to Whitney Portal. Hams meet in Lone Pine Fri evening Sept 27 to organize. The ride is overnight, 3 PM Sat to Sun Sept 29 AM. RVs used at rest stops but not required. Details available. Sam's Radio Hams then have an RV campout, Sept 29-Oct 2 at nearby Boulder Creek RV Park with hookups and shade trees.
