## Controllers' Preamble: (Announcement when opening the net)

- Please stand by for the Stu Rock Amateur Radio Club Tuesday night net (W8NJH). (Wait 10 seconds).

- Recognize check-ins.
- Beginning at the top of the list, we have ..... How are you this evening .....?
- This is W8NJH for the Stu rock Tuesday night net. We will now pause for more check-ins. All other check-ins please come now.
