With the help of Martin Wade N5PZJ, During our January meeting, the paperwork was finalized for the 501c3 -non profit tax forms and a club incorporation that was needed for the non-profit status. Signing the papers were President Guy W5ZIM, V-P Mike KC5OKP, and Sec/Tres Ronnie KD5GAG. We received both our tax number and our incorporation from the state in the Month of Feburary and hopefully by April, we will have a Checking account and a P.O.Box for the club.

Club Bylaws
