After the formal part of the evening, a welcome was extended to Dave Wilkins, ZL1MR, our guest speaker for the evening Dave spoke about his recent Stewart Island trek. Dave described in very interesting fashion, accompanied by excellent projected still pictures, how he and 3 others spent 14 days walking 152 Kilometers in the normally reverse direction trek of the island. Among the many special points about the trip explained and shown were.

- Food stashed at a convenient place for later pick-up during the walk.
- The amazing and varied types of landscape and fauna.
- Their experience with mosquitoes and sandflies.
- The sighting of deer, kiwi, Hoy Ho penguins and seals.
- The meeting of tourists traversing in the usual direction by day and in the huts.
- The amount, selection and type of food carried and stored previously for the 14-day period.
- The many and varied tracks and terrain experienced during the walk. Some of the extraordinary geologic character and formations observed.
- His very portable 40 and 80-meter antenna and Yaesu 817 rig along with battery and solar panel charging arrangements and some of the contacts he made during the trek.
- Remnants of early logging and tin mining.
- Some very beautiful bays and beaches fortunately saved from development with DOC managing the island reserve.
- The many huts provided at certain points around the island.
- The provision of hunting blocks with aircraft access.
