AREC Section Meeting






Club Nets

Digital Modes Radio/Computer Interface



The above picture is of a simple transceiver to computer interface. It consists of two small 600/600-ohm isolation transformers and an opto coupler. The result is that the Radio and Computer are electrically separated and this minimises any possible damage to stray currents. This can be used with many different computer packages such as UI-View with excellent results. Two shielded cables go to the speaker and microphone of the sound card and another two cables go to a RS232 port for switching the transceiver.
