AREC PRS channel 11 is 'Calling and Emergency'

Doing a bit of googling I discovered that three different reputable websites said that PRS channel 11 is intended to be used for calling and > emergency. I'd been curious to know if there was any organised calling/emergency channel (apart from local repeaters) as recent CD exercises and events showed that there were a significant number of PRS radios out there in the general population, and it seemed that promoting such a channel might be helpful to improve the usefulness of these communication assets. For example, including a "Please tune your PRS radio to channel 11 in the event of a Civil Defence emergency" or something like that in CD adverts.

I don't know about other regions, but here in Canterbury the local PRS repeater seems to be a clown magnet and extended listening is damaging to one's sanity, however leaving a radio sitting on channel 11 is far less stressful and likely to be less intrusive.
