ZL1VRR Silent Key

The club is sad to record the death of Ross ZL1VRR on Wednesday 3 August 2011. Ross died at Auckland Hospital unexpectedly after having been admitted for a heart problem. Ross was a willing club member and worked tirelessly for the club. He was always first to put his hand up when there was a task that needed attention. Ross was on the committee and had been for most of the 20 or so years that he had been a ham. Currently he was Vice President and the AREC Section Leader. Ross was always active at the Field Day Stations and assisted with radio communications at motor Rallies, the Annual Auckland Santa Parade and Horse Endurance events. Ross was diabetic and this condition lead to kidney failure and the need to be on dialysis for the last 10 years. This only slowed him a little and by buying a motor home he managed to carry on most of the activities that he enjoyed by taking his kitchen and bathroom with him. Ross's death notice is reproduced below.

He described how the impedance of the cable varies depending on the diameters of the inner and outer layers. Vaughan passed around samples of many different types of coax and described the properties of each. He gave practical experiences of installing and trouble shooting on installations. Skin effect was well described with a diagram that grabbed our attention before getting into detail. Thanks Vaughan for a very informative talk.

No AREC activities are planned; however there will need to be a meeting this month to appoint a new section leader.
