The September meeting will be a talk by Roy ZL1WI on a Marconi LCR Bridge that he has restored.

August Meeting

At the August meeting we had a talk on Marine Navigation given to us by John Turnwald ZL1JT. John talked about the "Road Rules" of the sea. He stressed the importance of adequate preparation before setting out and the importance of common sense if one is to stay alive while boating. John went into the system of buoys within the harbour and how to read them and keep in the channel. John talked of the need to have on board some basic navigation equipment such as a compass should fog descend and landmarks become obscured. He then went on to discuss more sophisticated equipment such as GPS, depth finders, and marine charts. He finished with a brief introduction on sextants and converting a celestial observation to Latitude and Longitude using the "Norrie" tables. There was discussion on radio communications and on the licencing requirements for both the ship and the radio operator.
