#### Horse racing at Lake Otamatearoa

It is now two years since the club last used the lake at Whiriwhiri as a base for HF Field Days.

The article below appeared in the May 2018 issue of the newsletter of Franklin Historic Society, and gives an outline of the venue of our operating space when it was a country race track.

The Waiuku Picnic Racing Club held its first annual meeting at Lake Otamatearoa, Whiriwhiri, 15 March 1952. The racecourse around the lake had been formed on farmer Jack Muir's property by local horse racing enthusiasts using

borrowed bulldozers. It took several years before railings were built between the course and the lake.

The tents seen in this photograph were later replaced by permanent buildings erected using donated timber.

Equalisator race meetings were held annually at the lake for more than 25 years, with a silver jubilee meeting being held on 7 February 1976. The course remained in occasional use during the 1980s, but it had been abandoned by the time the Waiuku Racing Club amalgamated with the Counties Racing Club in August 1991.
